

**COUNTY ORDINANCE NO. 25-2007 series**  
**CITY ORDINANCE NO. 293**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ARTICLE II, SECTION 215  
OF THE TAYLORSVILLE-SPENCER COUNTY JOINT  
PLANNING AND ZONING COMMISSION REGULATIONS  
PERTAINING TO ELECTRONIC SIGNS**

Ordinance is amended as follows:

Electronic Signs

Definition:

Sign whose alphabetic, numeric, pictographic, or symbolic information content can be changed or altered on a fixed display screen composed of electronically illuminated segments; includes LED (Light Emitting Diode), LCD (Liquid Crystal Display) and other similar technologies.

Electronic Signs Prohibited:

- 1.) Electronic Signs shall be prohibited in the following zoning districts: AG-1, AG-2, R-1, RM-1, R-2, and R-3 Zoning Districts.
- 2.) Electronic Signs with continuous flashing, blinking, or oscillating messages are prohibited.

Electronic Signs Permitted:

- 1.) Electronic Signs shall be permitted in B-1, B-2, B-3, I-1, and I-2 Zoning Districts subject to the following:
  - i.) Electronic Signs shall only be displayed on allowable freestanding or monument signs and shall not exceed allowable height requirements for the zoning district in which the sign is located.
  - ii.) Square Footage of Electronic Sign shall not exceed 30% of the total allowable square footage for freestanding or monument signs for the zoning district which the sign is located or shall not exceed 32 square feet, which ever is lesser.

- iii.) No more than one single or double sided electronic sign shall be attached to a permitted, conforming freestanding or monument sign per parcel or business.
