

**Spencer County, Kentucky
Ordinance No. 6
Fiscal Year 2008 Series**

An Ordinance Relating to the Adoption of Road(s) onto the County Road System

Whereas, written request has been made to the Spencer County Fiscal Court to formally adopt the following roads within the Heritage Hills subdivision onto the Spencer County Road System; and

Whereas, the road(s) on the request have been inspected and found to meet all current road specifications with the headwall exception noted below;


Now Therefore, Be It Ordained by the Fiscal Court of Spencer County, Commonwealth of Kentucky that the Fiscal Court does hereby adopt onto the Spencer County Road System the following road(s) for limited maintenance, such as snow removal and right-of-way trimming, with official mileage and speed limit as designated:

**Lincoln Trace, 0.446 mi, 25mph
Withrow Place, 0.087 mi, 25mph**

Be It Further Ordained by the Fiscal Court that the minimum road bond on Lincoln Trace shall be posted and remain at the full rate of \$100,000/mile or \$_____ until the headwalls are constructed; after headwall construction is complete, the bond may reduced to the 50% rate on 1,900 feet with the remaining length to remain at the full rate for access to Phase 2. The minimum bond on Withrow Place may be reduced to the 50% rate or \$_____ as of the date of this ordinance. The minimum bonds shall be held by the Fiscal Court for at least one year after the adoptive date of this ordinance. After a satisfactory annual inspection and the bonds are released, the County agrees to accept full maintenance responsibility for these roads.


Given first reading and approval on August 20th, 2007 .
