An Ordinance Relating to the Adoption of a Road(s) onto the County Road System

**Whereas**, written request has been made to formally adopt the roads in Sycamore Summitt subdivision onto the Spencer County Road System, and

**Whereas**, the roads in question has been inspected and found to meet all current road specifications,


**Now Therefore, Be It Ordained** by the Fiscal Court of Spencer County, Kentucky that the Court does hereby adopt onto the Spencer County Road System the following roads(s) for limited maintenance such as snow removal and right-of-way trimming, with official mileage and speed limit as designated:

Stephanie Avenue, 0.300 mile, 25 mph speed limit  
Leann Drive, 0.100 mile, 25 mph speed limit

**Be It Further Ordained** by the Fiscal Court that the required road bond on this road will be held by the Court for one year after the adoptive date of this ordinance. After the bond is released the County agrees to accept full maintenance responsibility for the said road.

Given second reading and adoption on January 6<sup>th</sup>, 2003.
